Bed Pocket

Here is another quick & cute project for those infamous scraps of leftover fabric....

The other day, I was wandering through town to look for a gift for a friend who just had a baby. I ended up with a cute looking crib organiser, for diapers and toys. You have probably seen them. So practical! Everything within arm's reach.



This inspired me to make a similar “organiser”, because sleeping at events can be a bit of a challenge, right? I mean... bed bunks.... Where is my night stand? Where do I put my glasses and flash light?

Here we go. First you cut two pieces of fabric measuring 20x35cm (you can even assemble these from different scraps). I have used two pieces of linen, a light and a dark brown.

Then cut the straps, I have cut four pieces of 5x30cm.



Stitch the straps first, right sides facing each other, leave an inch to turn the fabric. After turning, stitch hole. When the straps are done, pin them to one of the bigger pieces of fabric.



Stitch the two pieces together (right sides facing each other); make sure the straps are on the inside, leave an inch to turn the fabric. Cut the corners before turning and after turning stitch the hole. Then press, press, press!!

Fold the double layered pieces of fabric and stitch a pocket. Done! Enjoy using it at events ;)
